House wines

White

Castillo Del Morro Airen Sauvignon Blanc Spain £12.95

A rascal amongst whites – either sup it at the bar or allow it to tantalise your tasting tackle with fish or curry.

Red

Castillo Del Morro Tempranillo Syrah Spain £12.95

Super with one of our fillets – or equally good as a quaffer.

The 'A' List – These wines have been specifically selected and tested at this year's Silver Bay tasting – enjoy!

White

Nostros Reserva Sauvignon Blanc Chile £14.95

Crisp with citrus and grapefruit and dead easy to drink.

Anglesey Chardonnay Australia £14.95

A stylish Ozziel, er well it's from Australia at least.

Alpha Zeta Pinot Grigio Italy £16.95

A cheeky little Italian without being too impudent!

Rose

Mirabello Pinot Grigio Rose Italy

£14.95

Unashamedly one for the ladies – it's dry, fresh & fruity, and good to drink with cold meats (so if you're a bloke you'll get away by drinking this with a ham sandwich), seafood (fish n' chips will qualify for the lads) or if you're a secret Rose drinker then take it with a Guinness chaser and no-one will ever know.

Red

Caliterra Reserva Merlot Chile

£14.95

Second only to Ivan Zamara as the most famous of things to originate from Chile – like Zamara, this is smooth on the uptake and quick to score – at this price it's definitely a 'back of the net!' special!

Anglesey Shiraz Australia

£14.95

The name is entirely coincidental! – It's as ripe as you like and has a liquorice hint that would put Bassets to shame.

Navajas Crianza Rioja Spain

£16.95

Superb with red meat or a plate full of stinking bishop (of the cheese variety!).

Casa Defra Prosecco Italy

£16.95

A 'sunshine' special – ideal for a celebration like 'it's Wednesday'! – drink anytime with anything (but preferably your mates).

Roualet Desbordes Brut Premier Cru NV
